An abstract, hand-knotted floral pattern draws inspiration from traditional tiles.

Inspired by the tilework seen throughout Soho House Paris, our Edwardson rug is carefully hand-knotted to create an abstract floral motif that mimics the pattern mixing often seen with traditional tiles. Due to the use of artisanal techniques, it takes our artisans up to six months to complete each rug.

Composition: Pile: 100% Wool, Base: 49% Polyester, 44% Cotton, 7% Viscose, Overall: 56% Wool, 22% Polyester, 19% Cotton, 3% Viscose

Care instructions: Vacuum regularly on a low setting. Do not use heavy duty vacuums. Blot spills immediately with a soft, dry cloth, spot clean with mild soap if needed; occasional professional cleaning may be required. Do not dry clean. If loose end appears, do not pull; instead clip with scissors and tie a knot at the loose ends. Avoid direct exposure to sunlight. Rotate rug occasionally to equalize wear, if the rug gets wet, place it on a flat surface to dry. Store your rug by rolling, and wrap with cloth for protection. Rug pad recommended. with a soft, dry cloth, spot clean with mild soap if needed; occasional professional cleaning may be required. Do not dry clean. If loose end appears, do not pull; instead clip with scissors and tie a knot at the loose ends. Avoid direct exposure to sunlight.
